AWARDS ACCEPTANCE. Note that it is strongly preferable, but not absolutely required, that award winners be present to receive their award. Awards will be presented at the GRC Annual Meeting in Reno, Nevada, October 14-17, 2018. The GRC will advise award winners of the specific times and locations of the presentations.
